Jason is a member of the board of the Center for Jewish Studies at the University at Albany, where he earned a BS in Business Administration.

Jason Brzoska said, “I’m excited to be helping MJL build its audience and expand its operations. Establishing our headquarters in New York is an important step in that plan.”
